



Habitat For Humanity To Build Four Homes In Five Days

A home building blitz is underway in Oceanside. San Diego Habitat for Humanity is building four homes in five days in an annual effort to make affordable housing a reality for local families.

An estimated 500 professionals will build four homes from start to finish by Friday afternoon.

"We have families that have been chosen for each of their houses, and they are partner families, so they're going to be doing some sweat equity on this project," said Elizabeth Neubrand with San Diego Habitat for Humanity. "Each family puts in about 500 hours. They're not able to help out with the building of their houses because we're using professionals, but they will be able to help build those of their neighbors."

Turner Construction, PCL Construction, Flatiron and Swinerton Builders are all donating manpower for the blitz.
